

Hydrangea macrophylla 'Blushing Bride' (b

Every bride is beautiful, but this one is extraordinary. Introducing 'Blushing Bride' (b) from the Endless Summer® collection. Her beauty is defined by pure white mopheads which gradually take on a subtle blush of pink as they mature, and an ability to re-bloom throughout the season on both old and new growth. Deep, dark green foliage accentuates her colouring.

Climate:	Cool temperate to warm temperate.
Soil:	Adaptable to most well-drained soil types. Keep soil evenly moist. Mulching is beneficial. Tolerant of both acidic and alkaline soils.
Planting:	Dig a hole one and half times wider than container the plant came in. Roughen the sides and bottom of the root ball. Top of the root ball should be level with surrounding soil surface. Fill in around the roots with soil, and water in your plant thoroughly. Mulch is beneficial after planting.
Fertiliser:	Hydrangeas may require a slow release fertiliser in early spring for good flower production. Over feeding hydrangeas may result in dark green leaf production with fewer flowers.
Size:	1.2 x 1.2 metres.
Culture:	Endless Summer® Hydrangeas bloom on both new and old wood, and re-occur in bloom during summer and early autumn.
