JAPANESE MAPLE Acer palmatum 'Mikawa Yatsubusa'

Almost a natural bonsai, this very small maple is ideal for containers.

Foliage: Green leaves and multibranched. Leaves grow closely together producing a unique and dense leaf cover. Autumn tones are a feature in vibrant colden, orange, red and

bronze hues.

Flowers: Insignificant


Fruit: Samara

Culture: Adaptable to a range of soil types however prefers a moist, well drained soil. Should not be planted in a highly exposed situation where hot dry winds may stress the tree

and dry or burn foliage.

Size: 1.5 x 1.8 metres.
