

OAKLEAF HYDRANGEA

Hydrangea quercifolia

'Prinsnow' Snow Queen®

Selected for its dense growth habit, good autumn colour and the unique ability to hold its bloom panicles in an upright position, providing a magnificent display. Generally regarded as being one of the premier forms of Oakleaf Hydrangea.

- Foliage:** Medium to large sized oak-like foliage, to 12 cm long. Deep green colour that holds up well through summer, then turns many shades of reddish-mahogany to burnt-orange in autumn.
- Flowers:** Abundant, very large, white tapered flower panicles which develop a pink tinge with age. The blooms which are approximately 20 cm long are borne on strong, erect stems.
- Fruit:** An insignificant capsule.
- Culture:** Grows and flowers well in both full sun and semi-shade. Autumn colour is best in full sun. Prefers moist soil. Mulch can be beneficial to keep soil moist and cool. Pruning in winter is recommended to encourage larger flowers.
- Size:** 2.5 x 2 metres.
