

CREPE MYRTLE

Lagerstroemia fauriei

'Fantasy'

This large-sized tree has become very well-known overseas for its exceptional ornamental bark and white flowers from mid- to late summer. Good heat tolerance and the ability to withstand periods of moderate drought make it suitable for use as an amenity tree. Ideal for use in parks and gardens, street planting, or as a specimen.

- Foliage:** Lustrous, deep green foliage changes to bright golden-yellow and orange in autumn.
- Flowers:** Produces large panicles of small white flowers. The blooms remain on the tree for an extended period during summer.
- Fruit:** A small woody capsule of little significance.
- Culture:** Adapts well to a range of sites and will tolerate periods of moderate drought and heat once established. Prefers moist well-drained soils in full sun. Reported to be pest free with excellent resistance to powdery mildew.
- Size:** 9 x 8 metres.
