## CREPE MYRTLE Lagerstroemia fauriei 'Kiowa'

Lagerstroemia fauriei 'Kiowa' combines the qualities of disease resistance, showy white flowers and ornamental bark to provide an excellent, medium size tree for a range of settings.

Foliage: Glossy green foliage shows excellent disease resistance. Autumn

colour is a good orange-red to yellow.

Flowers: Long-lasting, terminal panicles of small, pure white flowers are borne

from mid-summer.

Fruit: Tiny capsules of little significance.

Culture: Adaptable to a wide range of conditions with good drought and

heat tolerance. Best in moist, well-drained, slightly acidic soils in a position receiving full sun. Reported to be pest free with excellent

resistance to powdery mildew.

Size: 8 x 7 metres.

Prune each limb by 50% just above a bud. Remove all broken or any unwated limbs.
