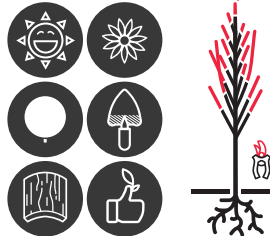

This tough, powdery mildew resistant cultivar is of great ornamental value for its abundant white flowers and attractive bark and foliage. This large rounded shrub can also be grown in large containers and makes an excellent garden specimen.

- Foliage:** Young leaves tinged strongly with bronze. Mature dark green lustrous leaves turning dark purplish-red in autumn.
- Flowers:** Pure white flowers with prominent gold anthers borne in panicles up to 18 cm long and 12 cm wide. Summer to early autumn.
- Fruit:** Insignificant capsules.
- Culture:** Adaptable to a range of conditions, however it is best in moist, well-drained, slightly acidic soils in a position receiving full sun. Moderate drought and heat tolerance. Demonstrates resistance to powdery mildew.
- Size:** 3 x 3 metres.
