# CREPE MYRTLE

## *Lagerstroemia indica x L. fauriei*

### 'Lipan'

Bred and selected for its resistance to powdery mildew. A popular cultivar from the Indian Summer® range, *Lagerstroemia* 'Lipan' is tough and has year-round interest including a long flowering period. Useful around buildings, carparks and along fence lines.

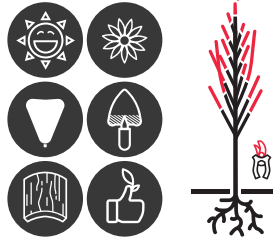
- Foliage:** Dark green leaves, turning light orange to russet in autumn.
- Flowers:** Masses of medium lavender coloured flowers in large panicles are produced on current season's growth in summer.
- Fruit:** Insignificant capsules.
- Culture:** Best in moist, well-drained, slightly acidic soils in a position receiving full sun.
- Size:** 4 x 3 metres.

Remove all broken or unwanted limbs.
