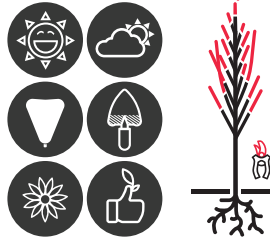
Lagerstroemia indica x L. fauriei

'Natchez'

A very popular cultivar with excellent white flowers and highly attractive exfoliating bark. The extremities of the branches can become pendulous giving a slightly weeping effect which is made more dramatic with the production of large white inflorescences. *Lagerstroemia* 'Natchez' is an adaptable tree, suitable for a wide range of landscape settings.

- Foliage:** Glossy mid-green leaves changing to reddish-bronze in autumn.
- Flowers:** Prolific white flowers in large terminal panicles produced on current seasons growth from mid-summer through to early autumn.
- Fruit:** Insignificant capsules.
- Culture:** Adaptable to a range of conditions, heat and some dryness but requires adequate moisture during establishment. Bred for resistance to powdery mildew. Best in moist, well-drained, slightly acidic soils in a position receiving full sun.
- Size:** 8 x 6 metres.
