## CREPE MYRTLE

### *Lagerstroemia indica x L. fauriei* 'Sioux'

Bred and selected for its exceptional attributes and resistance to powdery mildew. A showy, narrow-growing small tree with masses of intense pink flowers in summer, highly ornamental bark and very good autumn colour. *Lagerstroemia* 'Sioux' is best planted in front of contrasting backgrounds, such as evergreens, that will highlight blooms during summer.

- Foliage:** Dark green, thick up to 8 cm long. Good, strong autumn colour of coppery-brown to bright red.
- Flowers:** Medium to hot-pink flowers are borne in large panicles on the ends of current season's growth.
- Fruit:** Insignificant capsules.
- Culture:** Best in moist, well-drained, slightly acidic soils in a position receiving full sun.
- Size:** 4.5 x 3 metres.
