Lagerstroemia indica x L. fauriei

'Zuni'

A very free-flowering and tough shrub or small tree providing interest throughout the year. *Lagerstroemia* 'Zuni' is among the smaller growing cultivars in the Indian Summer® range making it excellent for use in such areas such as small gardens, road median strips and public forecourt plantings.

- Foliage:** Glossy, leathery, medium green leaves turn reddish-orange to dark red in autumn. Young growth tinged red.
- Flowers:** Masses of pinky-lavender coloured flowers produced on current seasons growth from mid-summer to early autumn.
- Fruit:** Insignificant capsule.
- Culture:** Adaptable to a range of conditions, heat and some dryness but requires adequate moisture during establishment. Moderate resistance to powdery mildew. Best in moist, well-drained, slightly acidic soils in a position receiving full sun.
- Size:** 3-4 x 3 metres.

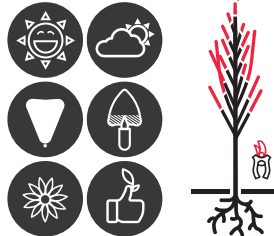


Lagerstroemia indica x L. fauriei

Remove all broken or unwanted limbs.
