CRAB APPLE *Malus*

'Criknzam' Crimson Knight™

Large deep-red flowers in spring make this crab apple an excellent choice for any garden. The new leaves emerge during spring having an attractive purple-bronze tone and turn to orange tones during autumn. Can have dark maroon bark when young.

- Foliage:** Quite small ovate foliage is purple-bronze in tone and turns to orange tones in autumn.
- Flowers:** Large single flowers are produced en-masse in mid spring and are a feature of the plant.
- Fruit:** When conditions are favourable small crab apples can be produced
- Culture:** Prefers full sun. Water often until well established. Should be given a deep soaking when dry.
- Size:** 8 x 4 metres.

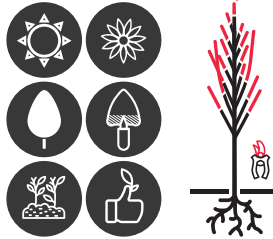
