CRAB APPLE Malus 'Criknzam' Crimson KnightTM

Large deep-red flowers in spring make this crab apple an excellent choice for any garden. The new leaves emerge during spring having an attractive purple-bronze tone and turn to orange tones during autumn. Can have dark maroon bark when young.

Foliage: Quite small ovate foliage is purple-bronze in tone and turns to orange tones in autumn.

Flowers: Large single flowers are produced en-masse in mid spring and are a feature of the

plant.


Fruit: When conditions are favourable small crab apples can be produced

Culture: Prefers full sun. Water often until well established. Should be given a deep soaking

when dry.

Size: 8 x 4 metres.
