CRAB APPLE Malus 'Matttom' Tom Matthews 'Matttom'

This showy selection of crab apple was introduced to Australia by Fleming's Nurseries and features a colourful display throughout the seasons. In spring, vibrant, vivid, scarlet-red flowers compliment the bronze-red foliage. The flowers are followed by an abundance of medium-sized clusters of small, dark, red-purple fruits from autumn to late winter.

Foliage: Mid to dark green tinged with bronze, particularly on the new growth.

Flowers: Brilliant, vivid, scarlet-red in spring.


Fruit: Clusters of small dark red-purple crab apples from autumn through to late winter.

Culture: Adaptable to varied soil conditions, but prefers a moist, fertile, well-drained acidic soil.

Should be planted in full sun for optimum flowering and fruiting.

Size: 3 x 3 metres.
