An Australian selection that shows good tolerance to heat and low levels of drought. This fastigate *Liquidambar* is ideal for positions that require a narrow growing form such as along a driveway or fence line, or as a windbreak or tall screen.

- Foliage:** Serrated margin with five to seven lobes, dark green throughout spring and summer, changing to yellow, orange and purples in autumn.
- Flowers:** Inconspicuous.
- Fruit:** Mature trees may bear small quantities of fruit.
- Culture:** Adapts to a wide range of soil types including wet sites, but performs best in moist, slightly acidic soil and in full sun. Will grow in coastal areas provided sea spray is minimal. Large, shallow root system requires adequate space for development. May be slow to recover from transplanting. Leaf chlorosis may occur if planted in soils with a high pH.
- Size:** 15 x 4 metres.
