

FLOWERING PEACH

Prunus persica

'Versicolour'

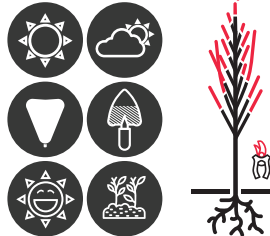
A double flowering peach that can provide an elegant spring display in the smaller home garden or park environment.

- Foliage:** Light green, lanceolate leaves with a long tapered point.
- Flowers:** Double flowers with a range of colour forms on the same tree from pale pink (almost white) to deep pink stripes or solid dark pink. Flowers open early-to-mid spring.
- Fruit:** Small hard fruit. Inedible.
- Culture:** Can adapt to various site conditions, but prefers moist, well-drained fertile soils and a position receiving full sun to part-shade. Flowers best in full sun and when pruned annually, immediately after flowering. Spraying to prevent leaf curl is recommended.
- Size:** 3 x 3 metres.
