## FLOWERING PEACH

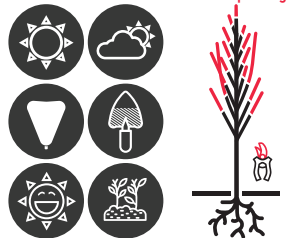
### *Prunus persica*

### 'Magnifica'

An early spring display of double crimson-red flowers on this flowering peach provides a bright splash of colour for small gardens and other landscapes.

- Foliage:** Light green lanceolate leaves to 14 cm long with a long tapered point.
- Flowers:** Double, crimson-red flowers to 4 cm diameter, almost completely covering the bare lateral branches in early spring.
- Culture:** Quite adaptable to varied site conditions, but prefers moist, well-drained fertile soils and a position receiving full sun to part-shade. Flowers best in full sun and when pruned annually immediately after flowering. Spraying to prevent leaf curl is recommended.
- Size:** 4 x 3 metres.
