An excellent choice for a small garden or for growing in containers. The unusual columnar habit lends itself to narrow garden beds. Suitable for fresh fruit, drying and cooking. Mid to late season.

Skin: A bright striped red blush on exposed fruit over a light green

ground colour.

Flesh: Creamy-white. Moderate juice. Medium firmness

Flavour: Good.

Culture: Prefers temperate climates with cool winters.

Pollination: Possibly Ballerina® 'Bolero', 'Maypole', 'Polka', 'Waltz'.

Size: 3.5 x .6 metres.
