Dwarf 'Granny Smith' Apple

A medium-sized fruit with rich green skin. Tart to sprightly flavour that will sweeten if left to hang on the tree. Excellent cooking apple as flesh holds its shape and flavour deepens with cooking.

Skin: Flesh:	Rich green with numerous conspicuous lenticels. Greenish-white. Crisp, firm. Excellent keeping qualities.
Flavour:	Very good. Can be tart - a sweeter flavour develops if the fruit is left to hang on the tree after leaf-fall. Maintains good flavour after cooking.
Culture:	Suitable for cool temperate zones of Australia with cool winters. Possible pollination partners include 'Gala', 'Golden Delicious', 'Jonathan', Pink Lady™, 'Red Delicious'.
Size:	Dwarf Fruit Tree.
