Foliage: Thick leathery foliage is an attractive deep bronze tone when

young, maturing to a dark green.

Flowers: Creamy white flowers, with tinges of pink are produced during late

winter, usually in clusters of seven.

Fruit: Conical shaped capsules approximately 1cm in width.

Culture: Like the species this tree is a strong grower, but is consistently

more compact and refined than is typical for the species.

Size: 15 x 7 metres.
