



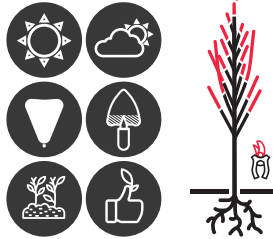
## CRAB APPLE

# *Malus transitoria* 'Schmidcutleaf' Golden Raindrops™

This unusual crab apple is valued for its finely textured foliage, showy golden crab apples and elegant form. Combined, these features create a small tree with a delicate appearance well suited for use in areas where space is limited. Makes a fine accent or specimen tree.

- Foliage:** The rich green foliage is finely textured and is deeply divided into three main lobes. Autumn colour is attractive and consists of reds, oranges and yellows.
- Flowers:** Tiny white blooms during spring. In some regions the flowering may not be prolific.
- Fruit:** Depending on climate, tiny golden-yellow crab apples are produced from summer into autumn and provide a wonderful display, especially when in full autumn colour.
- Culture:** Best in full sun. Adaptable to a wide range of soil conditions but prefers a moist, well-drained, slightly acidic soil. Reported (overseas) to exhibit good resistance to apple scab and powdery mildew.
- Size:** 7 x 4 metres.

### Bare-root pruning:



Prune each limb by 50% just above a bud.  
Remove all broken or unwanted limbs.
