White Mulberry

The White Mulberry is a fast growing deciduous tree with lush green foliage. Produces white elongated berries that ripen from late spring. Fruit can be used for fresh fruit, jam and wine.

Skin: Greenish-white.
Flesh: Greenish-white.
Flavour: Good. Sweet.

Culture: Deciduous. Suited to temperate, subtropical and some

tropical parts of Australia. Hardy in most conditions.

Pollination: Self-fertile. **Size:** 9 x 4 metres.
