GOLDEN-LEAFED EASTERN REDBUD

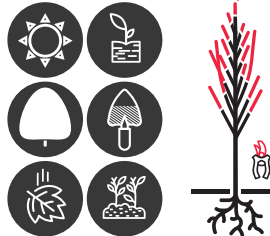
Cercis canadensis

'Aurelian'

A new Australian selection that tolerates full sun situations with less leaf scorch than other golden foliated *Cercis*.

- Foliage:** Large heart shaped foliage emerges in coppery tones and becomes yellow as it matures. Can become greenish in shaded sites and as the leaf matures.
- Flowers:** Masses of showy, lavender-pink pea-type flowers are produced on bare stems in early to mid spring.
- Fruit:** Can produce fruit similar to pea pods under ideal conditions. Pods can be persistent on the tree over winter.
- Culture:** Adaptable to a range of soil types including acidic and alkaline but prefers moist, well-drained soils. Will not perform well in high salt situations.
- Size:** 6 x 6 metres.

Prune each limb by 50% just above a bud.
Remove all broken or any unwanted limbs.
