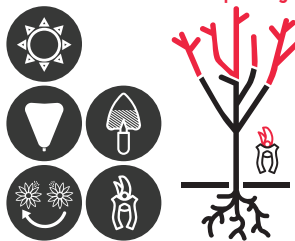

## 'Packham's Triumph' Pear

Used for fresh fruit, juice, drying, preserving and cooking. A very popular Australian pear that has good keeping qualities. The large fruit has an excellent flavour. Mid-season maturity.

- Skin:** Pale lemon-yellow when fully mature.
- Flesh:** White. Firm, very juicy and smooth textured. Good quality. Excellent storage qualities. Refrigeration necessary for about 14 to 21 days for fruit to ripen satisfactorily.
- Flavour:** Rich, very good.
- Culture:** Suitable for cool temperate zones of Australia with cool winters. Possible pollination partner includes 'Josephine'. Adequate cross-pollination is important.
- Size:** Standard Fruit Tree.
