'Sharwil' Avocado

Excellent eating - Subtropical

Popular avocado with an excellent, rich, nutty flavour. Vigorous growing rounded-spreading evergreen tree. Can set heavy crops. Small sized seed. Best suited to warm tropical regions. Mid-season harvest.

- Skin:** Green skin with a medium gloss. Generally easy to peel.
- Flesh:** Buttery to golden yellow. Good texture.
- Flavour:** Excellent. Rich and nutty flavour.
- Culture:** Water regularly until well established. Should be given a deep soaking in hot and dry conditions. Fertilise regularly during the growing season. Ensure soil is free draining and apply 100-150mm of mulch cover under the tree.
- Pollination:** Avocado's are classified an 'A Type' or a 'B Type'. To pollinate successfully you should pair an 'A Type' with a 'B Type'.
- Size:** 7 x 5 metres.
