'Shepard' Dwarf Avocado

Green skin - Semi-dwarf - Subtropical

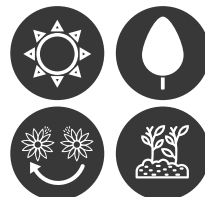
A green-skinned, medium-sized fruit with large seed and good eating quality. Compact semi-dwarf evergreen tree that can be frost sensitive. Crops well in warm subtropical climates. Early season harvest. Fruit ripens rapidly. Best eaten soon after harvest.

- Skin:** Medium-thick green, pebbled skin. Peels easily.
- Flesh:** Buttery texture and yellow in colour.
- Flavour:** Very good. Nutty flavour.
- Culture:** Water regularly until well established. Should be given a deep soaking in hot and dry conditions. Fertilise regularly during the growing season. Ensure soil is free draining and apply 100-150mm of mulch cover under the tree.
- Pollination:** Avocado's are classified an 'A Type' or a 'B Type'. To pollinate successfully you should pair an 'A Type' with a 'B Type'.
- Size:** 4 x 4 metres.
