'Arkin' Carambola (Star Fruit)

Self-fertile - Ornamental

Commonly referred to as star fruit, 'Arkin' is a subtropical, highly ornamental tree. Pink flowers are followed by succulent green, starshaped fruit that turn yellow when ripe.

Skin: Bright yellow to orange when ripe.

Flesh: Crisp. Sweet and juicy.

Flavour: Sweet, low acid.

Culture: Evergreen. Can crop up to twice a year. Perform best in frost

free locations. Can tolerate some shade but will not tolerate

water-logged soils. Prefers acidic soils.

Pollination: Partially self-fertile.

Size: 5 x 4 metres.
