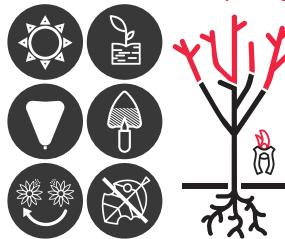


'Nijisseiki' Asian Pear

Used for fresh fruit and juice. One of the most popular Asian pears grown. 'Nijisseiki' combines the flavour and sweetness of a pear with the crispness and shape of an apple.

- Skin:** Yellowish-green with obvious lenticels.
- Flesh:** Creamy-white. Very juicy, crisp with good keeping qualities.
- Flavour:** Mild, becoming tart near the core. The fruit attains its best quality when allowed to ripen on the tree and enjoyed fresh.
- Culture:** Adaptable to warm and cold climate conditions.
- Pollination:** Possibly 'Sensation', 'Williams'. Can be partially self-fertile.
- Size:** Standard Fruit Tree.
