'**Nijisseiki**' Asian Pear

Used for fresh fruit and juice. One of the most popular Asian pears grown. 'Nijisseiki' combines the flavour and sweetness of a pear with the crispness and shape of an apple.

	Skin:	Yellowish-green with obvious lenticels.
	Flesh:	Creamy-white. Very juicy, crisp with good keeping qualities.
	Flavour:	Mild, becoming tart near the core. The fruit attains its best quality when allowed to ripen on the tree and enjoyed fresh.
	Culture:	Adaptable to warm and cold climate conditions.
Pollination: Possibly 'Sensation', 'Williams'. Can be partially		: Possibly 'Sensation', 'Williams'. Can be partially self-fertile.
	Size:	Standard Fruit Tree.
