'**Meiwa**' Kumquat

Pot friendly - Hardy - Prolific

This attractive, evergreen kumquat produces abundant round fruit that is larger than typical kumquats. Fruit is ideal for making marmalades, liqueurs and crystallising. Fruit will commonly be produced abundantly from spring through to mid-summer due to multiple flowering times.

Skin:	Deep orange. The rind is sweet, fine, and free of oil.
Flesh:	Orange. Seeded.
Flavour:	Very good. Semi-sweet.
Culture:	Evergreen. Water well during dry periods. Fertilise using a citrus fertiliser. More cold hardy than other citrus varieties.
Pollination: Self-fertile.	
Size:	5 x 4 metres standard. 4 x 2 metres dwarf.
