'Sunbob' Nectarine

Low-chill - Yellow Flesh - Semi-freestone.

'Sunbob' is a low-chill nectarine with medium-to-large yellow fleshed, sweet fruit. Suited to areas that receive minimal cold weather during the winter months. Avoid planting in areas prone to late frosts. Fruit matures mid to late in the low-chill season. Chill Units: 200

	Skin:	Rich red on a creamy-yellow ground colour.
	Flesh:	Firm, yellow.
	Flavour:	Very good. Sweet.
(Culture:	Prefers full sun. Water regularly until well established. Should be given a deep soaking when dry.
Pollination: Self-fertile.		Self-fertile.
	Size:	4 x 4 metres.
