Skin: Smooth. Orange.

Flesh: Orange with seeds. Firm.

Flavour: Very good. Sweet.

**Culture:** Deciduous. Performs well in cool temperate to subtropical

regions. Persimmons may be slow to break dormancy in spring.

**Pollination:** Self-fertile. **Size:** 3 x 3 metres
