Selected for its slightly dwarfing tree habit, 'Ichikikei Jiro' is an excellent non-astringent cultivar used for fresh fruit, drying and cooking. The ornamental value of the tree with fabulous autumn colours and heavy fruit crops make this a wonderful selection for any garden.

- Skin:** Smooth. Orange.
- Flesh:** Orange with seeds. Firm.
- Flavour:** Very good. Sweet.
- Culture:** Deciduous. Performs well in cool temperate to subtropical regions. Persimmons may be slow to break dormancy in spring.
- Pollination:** Self-fertile.
- Size:** 3 x 3 metres.
